All information received from identified individuals at or prior to the survey will be considered in making the accreditation decision. The information presented will not be debated with the eporting individual. Requests for presentation must be received at least two weeks prior to the survey in order to allow sufficient time to schedule presentations.

## IMPORTANT REMINDER

The **Notice of Accreditation Survey** (included in this confirmation packet) must be prominently posted throughout your organization for a minimum of 30 days. Please complete, photocopy, and post multiple copies of the **Notice** to achieve widespread awareness and opportunities for public feedback.

## Instructions

AAAHC policy requires that an organization applying for accreditation or re-accreditation announce the date of the survey and communicate the opportunity for public presentation of relevant information. This *Notice of Accreditation Survey* is to be posted within the organization's premises, in a manner intended to give public notice 30 days prior to the scheduled survey date. If the survey occurs less than 30 days after this packet is received, the *Notice* must remain posted for a period of *not less than 30 days*.

For organizations undergoing an AAAHC/Medicare Deemed Status survey, the *Notice* must be completed and posted upon receipt of the confirmation letter, and remain posted until the survey is completed.

In any case, the *Notice* must remain posted for a period of *not less than 30 days*.

The date and the name and title of the person responsible for posting should be recorded on the *Notice*. The *Notice* must be prominently displayed at all facilities, including each satellite, in public locations such as the lobby, reception area, cashier desk, or other public area, so that large segments of the public served are likely to view it. Posting must be at least as conspicuous as the AAAHC accreditation certificate.
