<b>1. When will the AAAHC August 2023 Virtual Conference be held?</b>	The live event will be <b>March 20-22, 2023</b> . The content will be available to registrants to access on demand for 30 consecutive days after the final day of the conference (April 21, 2023), allowing for maximum flexibility.

<b>3. How much does registration cost?</b>	<b>Early Bird</b> registration will be \$895 and is available through <b>February 20</b> . After this date, the full registration cost is \$995 per attendee.
<b>4. What kind of sessions can I expect to see at this virtual event?</b>	We are pleased to offer a blend of video, audio, and breakout/discussion groups to provide an engaging, multifaceted experience for attendees – including content tailored to the unique needs of Primary Care and Surgical/Procedural organizations. <b>5. Is there opportunity to earn CNE/CASC hours?</b>	Yes, the virtual conference will provide up to 15 AEU, 2 IPCHs (Infection Prevention Contact Hours) and up to 16 CNEs. Each conference registration allows the named registrant to claim available CEUs/IPCHs/AEUs (a single registration cannot be shared between multiple people wishing to claim educational credits). Directions on how to claim your CEUs will be provided post conference and noted under the ‘Resources’ tab in SpotMe.
<b>6. What kind of platform will I be using, and how will it work?</b>	We are pleased to invite each registrant onto our intuitive virtual conference platform powered by <b>SpotMe</b> . An instructional video on how to navigate the SpotMe platform will be available on the platform home page.
<b>7. What if I cannot attend a session during the scheduled time? Will I be able to watch recordings of the sessions after the conference is over?</b>	All conference sessions will be recorded and available to attendees at the end of each conference day. Additionally, these sessions can be accessed through <b>April 21, 2023</b> . Even if attendees do not participate in the live program or do not watch every session during the conference period, they will have another month to access content at their convenience.

<p><b>9. What if I am registered but cannot attend?</b></p>	<p>Registrants unable to attend may change the name on the registration to someone else in their organization and must notify AAAHC via email at <a href="mailto:education@aaahc.org">education@aaahc.org</a>, prior to the first day of the program.</p> <p>If a registrant is unable to attend the March 2023 Achieving Accreditation program and does not wish to move the registration to a colleague as described above, the registrant may transfer their March 2023 registration to the next Achieving Accreditation program (whether it is in person or virtual) at the current registration fee. To do this, AAAHC must receive written notice prior to the first day of the program to <a href="mailto:education@aaahc.org">education@aaahc.org</a>. March 2023 program transfers must be utilized by the next program with no exceptions.</p> <p>Registrants may cancel their registration for a full refund through February 24, 2023.
