March *Achieving Accreditation* onsite

This past March, AAAHC subject matter experts and staff convened for the two-day onsite event in Orlando. The conference, attended by more than 250 ambulatory professionals, allowed all to build relationships, learn and interact with peers and faculty experts, and experience a sense of community. The comprehensive agenda covered a wide range of topics, including performance metrics, best practices, and AAAHC Standards application and interpretation.

Highlighting the conference were sessions devoted to deep dives into the v43 Standards, which went into effect on April 3, 2024. Our experienced, expert faculty delivered insights anchored in the updated Standards and new architecture.

Emphasizing the importance of small group collaboration, the March program also offered a variety of interactive breakout sessions to encourage networking.

Read through the FAQs for our virtual conference in September.

When will the AAAHC virtual conference be held?

The live virtual event will be September 16–18, 2024. The content will be available to registrants to access on demand until November 2, 2024, allowing for maximum flexibility.

When and how can I register for the event?

Registration opened on March 25, 2024. Please visit the **registration page** on our website for more information.

How much does registration cost?

The Early Bird Rate is \$895 until June 17, 2024, and the Standard Rate is \$995 from June 18 to October 19, 2024.

What kind of sessions can I expect to see at this virtual event?

We are pleased to offer a blend of video, audio, and breakout/discussion groups to provide attendees with an engaging, multifaceted experience – including content tailored to Primary Care and Surgical/Procedural organizations’ unique needs. Sessions will include:

What equipment will be needed to participate in the virtual conference?

Our conference and resources can be accessed via computer through the SpotMe virtual conference web platform or the Eventspace mobile app. Access instructions will be provided via email the week of September 9, 2024.

An updated web browser such as Firefox, Google Chrome, or Safari is recommended. Internet Explorer is not supported. The Eventspace mobile app is available through Google Play and App Store.

For the best possible experience, a download bandwidth of 4.8 Mbps is needed to see live streams in full HD (1080p). A minimum download bandwidth of 1.5 Mbps is required to see the stream in low resolution. Connection testing and streaming quality can be tested in advance at test.spotme.com.

Cameras and microphones are not required or used by attendees for our main sessions but are required to attend breakout sessions to allow you to interact with our expert faculty.

What if I experience technical difficulties?
