Expect two full days of immersive Standards-focused learning, peer-to-peer breakout sessions emphasizing quality improvement, and fun informal engagements. 1. When will the AAAHC March 2025 Onsite Conference be held?	The live event will be March 20-21, 2025, with check-in and badge pickup beginning on March 19, 2025.
2. Where will the AAAHC March 2025 Onsite Conference be held?	Renaissance Orlando at SeaWorld 6677 Sea Harbor Dr, Orlando, FL 32821 The hotel group rate is available until Tuesday, February 25, 2025. Upon registration, a link to book hotel accommodations will be provided.
3. When and how can I register for the event?	Registration opens December 3, 2024 . Click the Register Now button on any page of the event website to register.
4. Can I register on behalf of someone else or a group?	Yes, you can submit registration on behalf of another user by completing the registration fields with the attendee's information. If you need to register more than one person, please follow the steps below. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) To begin registration, click Register Now2) Complete registration fields on the Personal Information page. Click Next to proceed3) Select registration type. Click Next to proceed4) Click Register Another Attendee and repeat steps 2-3 Once you have added all individuals, click Next to proceed to payment.
5. How can I access my registration details?	After payment is finalized, a confirmation page will load. The confirmation page includes a unique confirmation number. This is also sent via email. You can access your registration by selecting the Already Registered? page links located throughout the event website.
6. Will there be onsite registration?	To provide you with a customized educational experience, we will not allow onsite registration. There will be no onsite registration process. We anticipate this event will sell out, so register early!

<p>7. How much does registration cost?</p>	<p>Early Bird registration is \$1,195 and is available through December 18, 2024. After this date, the standard registration price is \$1,395 per attendee. Advanced registration is required.</p>

What kind of sessions can I expect to see at this onsite event?</p>	<p>We are pleased to offer a blend of live engagements, small discussion groups, and opportunities to connect with peers – including content tailored to primary care and surgical/procedural organizations' unique needs. Is there an opportunity to earn continuing education hours (CEUs)?</p>	<p>Each conference registration allows the named registrant to claim available Contact Nursing Education (CNE), Infection Prevention Contact Hours (IPCH), and Administrative Education Units (AEU). Our event platform will provide instructions on how to claim your CEUs.</p>
<p>10. How can I obtain meeting handouts/resources?</p>	<p>To be ecologically friendly, we are pleased to invite each registrant onto our intuitive, virtual conference event platform. All meeting materials, including slides and handbooks, will be available for attendees to view, download, or print approximately one week before the event. An email will be sent to registrants when available.</p> <p>A tutorial on using the platform will be available in the Home Feed to ensure your readiness.</p> <p>To summarize, there will be no printed resources onsite. If you prefer printed materials or cannot bring a mobile device to view resources electronically, please take advantage of our event platform before the event.</p> <p>We will use the event platform throughout the program to provide fun networking opportunities, such as the Activity Challenge. Additionally, attendees can network with staff, Surveyors, and other organizations during our networking reception.</p>
<p>11. What version of the handbook will be focused on during the conference?</p>	<p>The March 2025 onsite <i>Achieving Accreditation</i> conference will focus on the current handbook. You will be fully immersed in the architectural and policy changes associated with the current handbook, and the opportunity to ask questions about the <i>1095 Engage</i> accreditation management system.</p>
<p>12. What networking opportunities will be provided?</p>	<p>Engagement with subject matter experts in small group sessions will also be offered. Take your burning questions to the table for discussion and answers.</p>

<p>13. Will any sessions require advanced registration?</p>	<p>Advanced registration will be required for our Ask the Expert sessions to maximize your interaction opportunities with our expert faculty. Registration will occur through our event platform which will be launched the week of March 10, 2025. More information will be provided in our <i>Know Before You Go</i> resource and emailed to all registered attendees the week before the event.</p>
<p>14. Will any information about the AAAHC Standards and 1095 Engage system be provided?</p>	<p>As part of our continuous improvement, AAAHC has strengthened its focus on 1095 readiness, as reflected in the current handbook. Additionally, we have evolved our Standards architecture to leverage a new <i>1095 Engage</i> accreditation management system that unifies all programs through a consistent format.</p> <p>The conference will focus on current AAAHC Standards and their categories. We will be offering a focused session on Survey readiness and AAAHC updated policies and procedures that went into effect with v43, such as fee timing, updated Plan of Correction requirements, and completing an Annual Attestation.</p>
<p>15. What if I am registered but cannot attend?</p>	<p>Registrants unable to attend may change the name on the registration to someone else in their organization. They must notify AAAHC via email at education@aaahc.org, by Thursday, February 20, 2025.</p> <p>If a registrant cannot attend the March 2025 <i>Achieving Accreditation</i> program and does not wish to move the registration to a colleague as described above, the registrant may transfer their registration to the next <i>Achieving Accreditation</i> program (in-person or virtual). Any cost differences will be assessed based on the current rate of the next program. Program transfers must be used by the next program with no exceptions. To do this, AAAHC must receive written notice by Thursday, February 20, 2025, to education@aaahc.org.</p> <p>Through Thursday, February 20, 2025 refunds will be given minus a 15% administrative fee. AAAHC must receive a written cancellation notice via email at education@aaahc.org, by 11:59 PM CDT. If you registered as a group and the entire group must cancel, one cancellation request per individual is required. No refunds will be provided after that date.</p>
