BENCHMARKING STUDIES

Six-month studies show where an organization stands relative to its peer facilities. Organizations enter their study data into our secure online tool. At the conclusion of the study period, participating organizations receive a comprehensive report showing results at-a-glance.

TOOLKITS

Toolkits are designed to raise awareness of patient safety risks and best practice. Toolkits use current data and research on the topic and may include worksheets and forms for organizations to adapt into day-to-day operations.

The prestigious *Bernard A. Kershner Innovations in Quality Improvement Award* recognizes AAAHC-accredited organizations that have successfully implemented meaningful QI studies, resulting in changes to their operations.
